PHE NICE PH48 self-assessment tool for acute trusts

The self-assessment tool supports all of the recommendations applicable to acute services in NICE PH48, breaking the guidance down into four areas:

- systems required to implement the guidance
- · communication required
- training that will help staff to successfully implement the recommendations
- treatments that should be available to support staff and service users
